“Deep ruby color; smooth, clean and juicy cherry fruit; racy and lively with savory notes and good depth; silky, fresh and long; balanced and crisp.”



91 Points - Oct 2017

“This easy-to-like wine hits all the Pinot markers in top form from its medium-ripe red cherry and dried flower first nose to the hints of spice in its creamy oak and the supple, slightly velvety texture to its entry palatal impressions. It has great continuity across the palate, with no fade at any point, and its length and balance are spot on...”

“The 2015 Pinot Noir Twelve Clones is rock-solid and has an intriguing mix of old and new world characteristics. Offering notes of black cherries, wood smoke, and sous bois, it hits the palate with medium-bodied richness, juicy, vibrant acidity, and a great finish. It should age gracefully and is a charming effort well worth drinking.”



90 Points - Dec 2017

“Subdued cranberry, crushed rose petal, lavender and sweet sage notes show on the nose of this clonal mash-up. Tightly wound cranberry and red plum skin flavors show on the palate, brushed with anise and a hint of white pepper. This will probably be much more complex in the years to come.”



90 Points - Aug 2017

“Medium-light to medium ruby; attractive, fragrant, bright, red cherry and raspberry fruit aroma with hints of forest floor, dried herbs, and Asian spices; medium body; fleshy, supple, dark cherry fruit flavors with nice acidity, a trace of toasty oak, and a slight plushness in the mouthfeel; medium tannin; lingering aftertaste. Easy to drink and enjoy now.”
